


- If you correctly guess the sustainable practices from five (5) clues you win a cloth Sustainable Ramona bag.

Sustainable Ramona is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation organized to foster sustainability in Ramona. The mission of Sustainable Ramona is to lead the transition to a sustainable climate in Ramona with a healthy economy via education, partners, projects, promotions, and ultimately a profitable, independent electricity-producing area (micro-grid).

To date, the group has sponsored educational forums on the San Diego County climate action plan, water conservation, waste management, worm farming, composting, electrification of houses, and renewable energy along with two Earth Day Festivals, a Harvest Festival, and a Community Forum introducing the concept of an independent public utility using microgrid technology and renewable energy; and a symposium led by an existing community microgrid CEO as an example for Ramona to consider
